As an open-access journal, *AJME* publishes high-quality original research and scholarly articles across a broad range of topics in mathematics education. Currently, Prof. Gabriele Kaiser (University of Hamburg & ECNU) and Assoc. Prof. Xiaoli Lu (ECNU) work jointly as Co-Editors-in-Chief.

As *AJME* is sponsored by ECNU, authors are not required to pay any article processing charges (APC). The journal welcomes submissions in all areas of mathematics education, including but not limited to:

- Mathematics teaching and learning
- Mathematics curriculum and textbook research
- Mathematics teacher education and professional development
- International and comparative studies in mathematics education
- The use of digital and emerging technologies in mathematics education
- Interdisciplinary research involving mathematics education (e.g., STEM education with mathematics as a core discipline)

WRITE FOR AJME

AJME welcomes manuscripts based on methodologically sound empirical studies, as well as high-quality scholarly articles including literature review papers in mathematics education. In principle, all the manuscripts submitted to the journal are expected to be of general relevance for mathematics education at an international level and should not be limited to local perspectives. The journal encourages submissions from authors all over the world.

Submission: All manuscripts should be submitted electronically using *AJME*'s submission site at <https://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/mea>. All submissions will be reviewed in a single-anonymised review process.

Type and Length:

Original Research: Scientific manuscripts with clear research methods and structure.

- Word limit: should not exceed 8,500 words (including references), electronic supplementary material does not count to the word limit, but should not exceed 2,000 words

- Abstract: 150 to 250 words

- Keywords: up to 6 (in alphabetical order)

- Table/figure limit: no limit, adequate for the theme of the paper

Research Commentary: Manuscript on research methods, evaluation studies, published research on a certain topic, and other research-related issues.

- Word limit: should not exceed 4,000 words (including references)

- Abstract: up to 200 words

- Keywords: up to 6 (in alphabetical order)

- Table/figure limit: no limit, adequate for the theme of the paper
